# VOTE FROM HOME

## How can I vote from home?

**In order to request a ballot, you must be registered to vote.**

**REGISTER TO VOTE** - Eligible residents can register to vote online or by mail.

Fill out an application online at [register.votespa.com](https://register.votespa.com)

Voter Registration Applications are also available to download at [PhiladelphiaVotes.com/voters](https://PhiladelphiaVotes.com/voters)

Once you are registered to vote, you can request your ballot.

If you are applying for a mail ballot online, you must provide a PA Driver's License or PennDot ID number.

In Pennsylvania, you now have two options for mail ballots:

**Absentee ballot** – If you plan to be out of the municipality on election day or if you have a disability or illness, you should request an absentee ballot, which still requires you to list a reason for your ballot.

**Mail-in ballot** – If you aren't an absentee voter, you may apply for a mail-in ballot. You may simply request this ballot.

Once you successfully submit your application, the Philadelphia County Board of Elections will mail you your ballot along with instructions.

## Once you receive your ballot...

- Mark your ballot, following the instructions.
- Place your ballot in the secrecy envelope and then put the secrecy envelope into the official envelope.
- Be sure to sign the form, or your ballot may not count.
- Return your ballot to the Philadelphia County Board of Elections (1400 JFK Blvd. City Hall, Room 142) so it arrives on time.

The deadline to submit voted ballots is 8:00 PM on Election Day (Postmarks not honored).



## What if I don't have a Pennsylvania License or I.D.?

Registered voters without a Pennsylvania Driver's License or I.D. should download and print an absentee or mail-in ballot application from [apps.PhiladelphiaVotes.com](https://apps.PhiladelphiaVotes.com), fill out the form, and mail it to the Philadelphia County Board of Elections.

## Important Dates

**OCTOBER 19:**  
**Deadline to Register to Vote**

**OCTOBER 27:**  
**Last day to apply for a mail-in or civilian absentee ballot**

**NOVEMBER 3:**  
**ELECTION DAY and Last day for County Boards of Elections to receive voted mail-in and civilian absentee ballots.**
